
LIFE CYCLE OF A HONEY BEE

EGG:

A fertilized egg develops into a female worker bee. A nonfertilized egg develops into a male drone bee.

LARVA:


The egg
hatches within
three days.
The larva
looks like a
grub. It eats
nonstop,
molting as it
grows.

PUPA:

The larva spins a cocoon like a caterpillar.
Over 12 days, tucked in a cell, it will grow adult features.

ADULT:

When the pupa grows body hair, it's ready to live as an adult. It chews out of the cell and goes to work!
